INFORMATION HANDOUT FOR ZONING DETERMINATIONS

In most cases a zoning determination will be an interpretation of the ordinance by the Planning Commission. In cases where uses are not specifically spelled out in the zoning ordinance and the Planning Department feels that the proposed use could possibly be in general keeping with the uses authorized in such a zone, the staff will present the application to the Planning Commission for that determination. (BCC 11.52.100)

1. The applicant must submit a zoning determination form to the Planning Department at least three weeks prior to the next regularly scheduled meeting of the Benton County Planning Commission.
2. At the next regularly scheduled meeting, the Planning Commission will review the application for the newly proposed use. The applicant should be present to answer any questions the Planning Commission members may have relative to the application.
3. At the meeting the Planning Commission will make its interpretation of the ordinance concerning the proposed use. Written notification of the decision will be sent to the applicant.
4. The applicant may appeal the decision of the Planning Commission to the County Commissioners within 14 days after the public meeting if he finds the decision adverse to his best interests.
