



The Board of Benton County Commissioners is proud to announce the completion of the Clodfelter and Locust Grove Roads and cordially invites you to attend the Ribbon Cutting Ceremony on:

Monday, July 23, 2012 @ 10 am @ the intersection of Clodfelter Road and Locust Grove Road. 4 ½ miles west of Exit 114 on I-82 (SR 397 interchange)

This project improved 2.6 miles of Clodfelter Road, by reconstructing a section of roadway from Bently Road to C. Williams Road (C.E. 1778), and the new construction of 1.6 miles of Locust Grove Road from Clodfelter Road to Edwards Road (C.E. 1838). The work consisted of clearing, grubbing, removing pavement (C.E. 1778), excavation, embankment, culvert pipe installation, crushed surfacing, paving with HMA CI 1/2 inch PG 70-28, erosion control, beam guardrail, and pavement markings.

Cost: Approximately \$3,500,000

Funding: County Road Administration Board \$2,250,000
