



The Board of Benton County Commissioners is proud to announce the completion of the Antinori Road Project and cordially invites you to attend the Ribbon Cutting Ceremony on:

Tuesday, April 21, 2015 @ 1:30 pm @ the intersection of Antinori Road and Sunset Road. From Interstate 82 take Exit 96 for SR 225/Benton City. Go north 250 feet to SR224/Kennedy Road. Turn right onto SR224/Kennedy Rd and go east for 0.17 miles to SR224. Turn left onto SR224 heading northeast for 1.35 miles to Sunset Road. Turn left onto Sunset Road and head north for 1.62 miles. The site will be on your right.

This project constructed 0.90 miles of new roadway to complete the loop of Antinori Road from SR 224 to Sunset Road. The completed roadway provides improved access for wineries and vineyards in the area and is intended to promote tourism. The project was entirely funded by the adjoining land owners through a County Road Improvement District.

Cost: Approximately \$1,030,000
